 - Submit Perkins loan confirmation numbers to Business Office
 - Submit Stafford loan confirmation numbers to Financial Aid Office
 - Athlete? Purchase required college sports insurance policy
 - Acquire a computer user account through Computer Services Office for use on campus computers
 - Acquire a mailbox and key (dorm students only) from the Mailroom
 - Purchase books in Book Store
