

2011 Alumni Awards

Do you know a HLGU alum that fits the following criteria and needs to be recognized? Then nominate him or her for an alumni award!

Distinguished Alumnus – This is the most prestigious of the three awards. It is presented to a Hannibal-LaGrange University graduate for significant and broad accomplishments in business, their professional life or for state or nation. This award is for developed talent that reflects favorably on the quality of Hannibal-LaGrange University, the faculty and the administration. Qualifications include:

- Must be distinguished in his or her chosen business, profession or life work
- Must be a person of such integrity, stature, demonstrated ability and renown that the faculty, staff, students and alumni of the institution will take pride in, and be inspired by, his or her recognition
- May be deceased providing that during his or her lifetime he or she met the essential requirements of the previous subsections

Outstanding Service Award – This is presented to a Hannibal-LaGrange University graduate who has given outstanding service to the institution or his or her community. There are three categories:

- Outstanding Community Service
- Outstanding Human Service
- Outstanding Service to the University

Outstanding Young Alumnus Award – This is given to a Hannibal-LaGrange University graduate who is age 35 or younger for outstanding accomplishments in his or her profession, business, community, state or nation.

How to nominate: Send your nominee's name and a brief reason why they deserve the award to Alumni Director Lauren Youse ('05) at lauren.youse@hlg.edu or mail it to 2800 Palmyra Road, Hannibal, MO 63401.
