	<p style="text-align: center;">Please use this guide to assist you in completing the necessary steps to be considered for admission to the ASN program.</p>
1.	<p>Submit HLGU application to the Admission’s Office. Apply online: <a href="https://www.hlg.edu/apply/">https://www.hlg.edu/apply/</a></p>
2.	<p>Schedule an appointment to take the <b>HESI Admission Assessment (A2) Exam</b>. Email <a href="mailto:kathryn.martin@hlg.edu">kathryn.martin@hlg.edu</a> to schedule.</p> <p>You can purchase a study guide online or through the University Bookstore to prepare for the HESI exam. <i>HESI Admission Assessment Review, 4<sup>th</sup> Edition</i></p> <p>HESI A2 Exam content areas includes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Math</li> <li>▪ Grammar</li> <li>▪ Vocabulary</li> <li>▪ Reading Comprehension</li> <li>▪ Critical Thinking</li> </ul> <p><i>If a student can provide HESI scores covering the same content areas and taken in the last two years at a previous institution, acceptable scores will be considered. Tests taken will only be valid for 2 years.</i></p>
3.	<p><b>Day of Admission Assessment Exam:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Bring cash or check for \$45 to cover the cost of the exam.</li> <li>▪ Please bring a photo ID the day of the exam.</li> <li>▪ Please allow at least 3-4 hours to complete the exam.</li> <li>▪ Achieve acceptable scores on the Nursing Admission Assessment Exam: 77% in math and 77% in English Language Composite</li> <li>▪ Two attempts are allowed to achieve an acceptable score.</li> </ul> <p><i>Deficient scores in math will require remediation with proof of remediation between version one and version two of the test.</i></p>
4.	<p>Submit the following items to *Admissions and **Registrar’s Office (Make sure this is addressed to the appropriate office at Hannibal-LaGrange University, 2800 Palmyra Road, Hannibal, MO 63401)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ *High School transcript (if starting classes with less than 24 hours of transfer credit)       <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Or if within the last five years to prove pre-requisite courses</li> </ul> </li> <li>▪ *Evidence of acceptable scores on ACT or SAT. (if less than 24 credit hours)       <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Or if good score to earn points for student ranking</li> </ul> </li> <li>▪ **Official transcript(s) of all college credits earned</li> </ul>
5.	<p>Complete the following prerequisites with a grade of C or higher (<i>Must be completed prior to entering the nursing program</i>):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ One year of high school biology or one semester of college biology (lecture and lab; total of 4 hours).</li> </ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ One year of high school algebra or one semester of college-level algebra. All <i>incoming students must take the Math Placement Exam for placement in appropriate level class.</i></li> <li>▪ Anatomy and Physiology 1&amp;2 (lecture and lab; total of 8 hours).</li> <li>▪ Microbiology (lecture and lab; total of 4 hours) <i>*May also be taken during the summer term between first and second years of the ASN program.</i></li> </ul> <p>Students are required to have at least a 2.5 CGPA to be eligible for the program.</p>

<b>ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:</b>	
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ The Craigmiles School of Nursing accepts students once a year and begins the class cycle in the fall. Qualified applicants are ranked based on a combination of the ACT score, the CGPA, and the Admission Assessment Exam (A2) score. Additional credit is awarded for grades in prerequisite courses and completion of support courses as part of the overall ranking score. <i>Please talk with the Nursing Admissions Coordinator if you have questions about ranking.</i></li> </ul>
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Students who apply to the Craigmiles School of Nursing at Hannibal-LaGrange University must assume responsibility in fulfilling the steps as outlined above. If you have any questions the office staff will be happy to provide you with answers and/or assistance.</li> </ul>
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Any applicant who has been a student in another nursing program must request a letter to be sent from the Director of that program. The letter must state the reason for their withdrawal from the program and their status in regards to re-entry. <i>Contact the Nursing Admissions Coordinator to request a recommendation form. We must receive this completed form in order to continue with your application for entry into Hannibal-LaGrange University Craigmiles School of Nursing.</i></li> </ul>
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ The decision of the Nursing Admission Committee will be sent in writing to all applicants. Those accepted will receive further instruction. Once the class is filled, qualified applicants will be placed on a wait list and will be admitted to the program if openings occur, up to the first day of classes.</li> </ul>
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Those students who are not admitted to the school of nursing may wish to enroll in support courses and would be considered a pre-nursing student.</li> </ul>
