

As part of the graduation process, graduating candidates are asked to provide the institution information about their present employment status and future plans. This information is received through an online survey - Graduating Student Survey. To inform candidates about the survey and its location, the Registrar emails candidates a graduation checklist. The checklist includes the survey URL and other important information. Candidates can access the survey at: <http://www.hlg.edu/academics/acs/index.php>. As evidence of completion, the candidate or designee must obtain the Associate Dean for Academic and Career Services or designee's signature on the checklist.

The Graduating Student Survey is accessible twice a year – fall and spring semester. At least two weeks before the end of each semester, the Associate Dean for Academic and Career Services activates the online survey. The site is closed by the Associate Dean at the end of the semester.
