



## **LPN-RN Bridge Option**

To qualify for the **LPN-RN Bridge Option**, you must meet the following Guidelines for Admission:

- Minimum of 17 years of age;
- Meet General Admission Requirements for admittance to Hannibal-LaGrange University (*see the Admissions section of the HGLU Academic Catalog, current edition*);
- Complete a Nursing Application;
- Have a minimum grade point average (GPA) of at least 2.75 on a 4.0 scale in Nursing Support Requirements;
- Complete the following prerequisites with a grade of C or higher:
  - a. Achieve a C or better in the ASN's Science and Behavioral Science Support courses.
  - b. Prerequisite science courses\* will only be accepted if taken within 5 years prior to beginning the nursing program. The material from these courses is fundamental to students' success in nursing school. If a practicing LPN, the 5-year rule may be waived.
  - c. NUR 130 Health Assessment.
- Submit all required health, background check, and confidentiality documents.
- Submit copies of proof of vaccinations.
- Submit BLS CPR certification (American Heart Association).
- Complete any additional requirements per partnership affiliation agreements between HLGU CSON and clinical or partner organizations.
- Proof of active, unencumbered LPN license.
- LPN-RN HESI test (*LPN-ADN Entrance Exam*) score of at least 900 (maximum of 2 attempts).

*\*Must be taken with the previous 5 years. Otherwise, the prerequisite science courses will be required to be retaken.*

3. Advise the Admissions Department of your desire to enroll in the **LPN-RN Bridge**. You will be contacted by the Nursing Department Enrollment Team once we have been advised of your admission to HLGU.
