Must have earned a C or better in Science and Behavioral Science Support Courses.

b. Bible

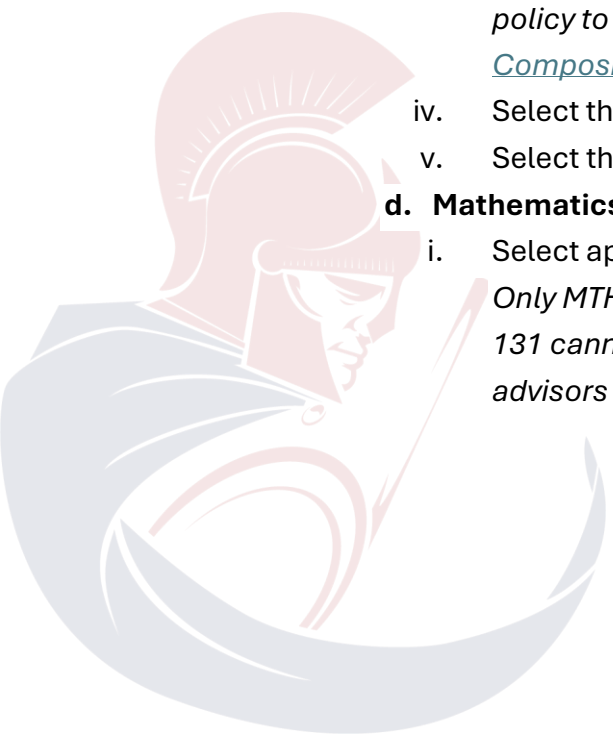
- i. BIB 113 Old Testament Survey (3 credits) or

Students may choose either BIB 113 or BIB 123.
- ii. BIB 153 Biblical Worldview (3 credits)

c. Humanities and Fine Arts

- ii. ENG 104 English Composition I (3 credits)
- iii. ENG 106 English Composition II (3 credits)

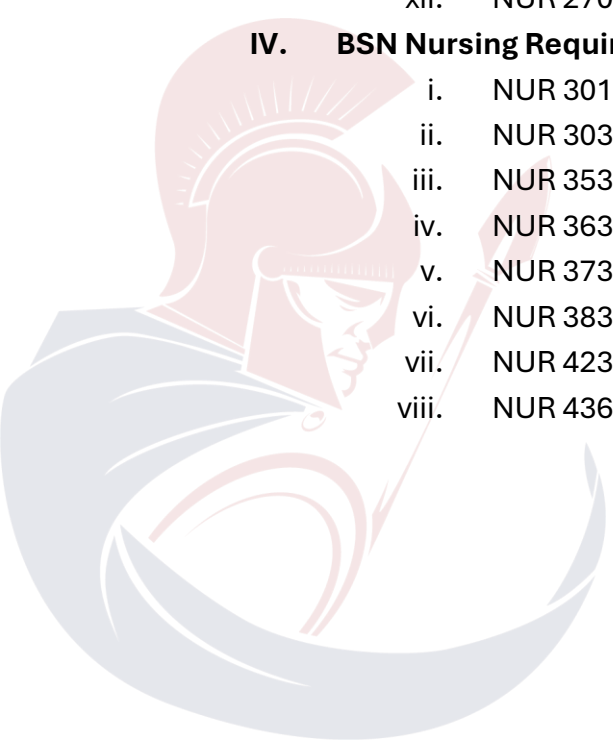
