MAJOR REQUIREMENTS

The liberal studies major (either BA with language or BS without language) is an interdisciplinary program which allows more flexibility than other majors. This major is designed by the student, but must be approved by the liberal studies advisor within the guidelines established by the university for this major and for the particular degree being sought.

Requirements:

A student who desires to major in liberal studies must:

1. Present to the liberal studies advisor, in writing, a proposed plan for the major. This proposal should be presented before the student has completed 76 semester hours of coursework. It should also include the student's rationale for not pursuing one of the traditional academic majors listed in the catalog.
2. Receive written approval for the plan from the liberal studies advisor. Once the plan has been approved, any change must also be approved by the advisor.
3. Use none of the required general education courses to meet the major requirements for the liberal studies major.
4. Include in the liberal studies major at least three courses (and at least 8 hours) from each of three academic departments. A core course from each department is prescribed; the list may be obtained from the liberal studies advisor.

NOTE: This program constitutes a single major with courses from three academic departments, not three separate majors.

5. Include at least 30 semester hours in the liberal studies major with at least one-third of the major courses taken from the 300 and 400 level. Pass each course in the liberal studies major with a grade of C or better.
6. Count no more than 40 hours from any one department toward the degree.
7. Meet both the General Education Requirements for the chosen degree (BA or BS) and the Graduation Requirements (see Academic Policies in the catalog).
