WHAT DOES THE THEATRE DEPARTMENT OFFER?

How do I Audition?

There are three possible ways to arrange an audition:

- 1) The preferred time to audition is the official Audition Day that is held in the spring of each year. Contact the Admissions Office at 1-800-HLG-1119 to sign up for this day.
- 2) If you are unable to visit campus on the date listed above, please feel free to visit another time. These arrangements can also be made through Admissions Office. Simply call 1-800-HLG-1119 and our admissions staff will help you set up a date and time for your audition.
- 3) If you are unable to audition in person, your situation will be discussed with the director and the option of audition by video will be considered. How do I prepare for the audition?

- You will need two, three- to five-minute monologues, memorized. They must be contrasting in style (for example: one comedy and one drama) and from a contemporary play.
- o Please bring a portfolio and/or resume, typed, including detailed performance experience and a headshot.
- o Three reference letters, one from each of the following: minister, teacher and friend. References cannot be from someone you are related to.
- o Three additional names, addresses and phone numbers for secondary references.
- o Be prepared to participate in improvisation activities
