
Hannibal-LaGrange University's COVID-19

Student Reference Guide



- Self-isolates***
- Close contacts identified and contacted
- -report to SL+ upon develop and/onotification for contact tracing for COVID-19
- Self-quarantines** for 14 days from close contact
- Self-isolation*** if symptoms develop and/or tests positive for COVID-19
- Low risk of infection
- Person C is not subject to quarantine unless Person B develops symptoms or tests positive for COVID-19
- *Close contact: is someone who was within 6 feet of an infected person for at least 15 minutes starting 48 hours before illness onset.
- **Self-quarantine: when someone separates and restricts their selves around others to see if they become sick.
- ***Self-isolation: when someone completely separates their selves around others after learning they are sick.
- + SL: Student Life

RETURN TO CLASS/NORMAL ACTIVITY (CDC GUIDANCE):

Person A: able to return 10 days after symptom onset and be fever free for 24 hours without the help of fever reducing medications and COVID-19 symptoms have improved.

Person B: able to return 14 days after self-quarantine as long as no symptoms become present.

Person C: is not required to self-quarantine unless symptoms occur or tests positive for COVID-19.

Residential Students: self-isolation space has been made ready for students who cannot travel home.
